

## CAMP QUINEBARGE—PERSONAL BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

You have chosen to attend Camp Quinebarge and camp life offers many unique opportunities and experiences to you as a camper. Beyond camp activities, camp offers you many opportunities to form new friendships and to meet the challenges of independence.

At Quinebarge, we encourage an atmosphere where campers and staff support one another with genuine respect. As a camper, it is your responsibility to help make camp life a positive and enjoyable experience for yourself, your fellow campers, and your counselors. All campers are expected to demonstrate high standards of conduct and to accept personal responsibility and consequences for their actions. You are expected to show honesty, courtesy, and consideration toward others. This includes all others with whom you may come in contact such as visitors and those whom you may meet when participating in activities away from camp.

We expect that each camper will exhibit the following personal behavior:

1. Campers are expected to follow directions and all camp rules and regulations established before arrival at camp as well as any which may be established during the camp session.
2. Campers shall not be involved in any way with smoking, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons, vandalism, theft, or any type of behavior that is judged by the staff to be detrimental to the health, well being, safety, or reputation of him/herself, or any member of the Quinebarge family.
3. It is understood that campers will use appropriate language at all times and that the use of profanity will not be tolerated.
4. All campers will remain in camp at all times unless on escorted approved camp activities which take place away from camp or for medical emergencies which may require transportation to our physician.
5. The use of all camp facilities and equipment carries with it the responsibility of leaving them in the same condition in which they were found. Campers will be responsible for all damage due to negligence which is not considered normal "wear and tear".
6. Each camper must sleep in his/her assigned cabin each night.
7. Harassment of campers for any reason will not be tolerated.
8. Campers may never enter any other camper cabin other than their assigned cabin.
9. Quiet hours in camp will be observed from lights out each evening until 7:30 AM each morning. At lights out, all campers must be in their cabins. Lights out time will be established in each of the cabin areas depending on the activities scheduled for each evening.
10. Common sense and respect and consideration for others should be practiced daily.

For violations of camp rules, campers may be sent home at the sole discretion of the Camp Director. In such cases, the parent/guardian will be contacted and the parents will bear the cost and the inconvenience of bringing the child home.
